

# A Bill to Expand H-1B Visas (L1)

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The H-1B Regular Cap shall be raised by 10,000 visas per year until it  
3 reaches a total of 150,000 visas offered. The H-1B Master's Exemption  
4 Cap shall be raised by 5,000 visas per year until it reaches a total of  
5 50,000 visas offered. All per-country visa caps shall be abolished.

6 **SECTION 2.** H-1B Regular Cap shall be defined as a limit placed on the number of  
7 foreign workers authorized to work in the United States annually under  
8 H-1B status. H-1B Master's Exemption Cap shall be defined as the  
9 number of applicants holding master degrees who are exempt from the  
10 regular cap.

11 **SECTION 3.** U.S Citizenship and Immigration Services shall oversee the  
12 implementation of this legislation.

13 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect the first day of the first fiscal year after  
14 passage.

15 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
