

**A Resolution to  
Encourage China to End Economic Relations with North Korea (L11)**

1   **WHEREAS,**   China is accounting for the majority of international trade with North Korea; and

2   **WHEREAS,**   North Korea has threatened the United States as well as the rest of the

3                   developed world with nuclear warfare numerous times; and

4   **WHEREAS,**   North Korea has committed flagrant human rights violations perpetrated by the

5                   regime in power; and

6   **WHEREAS,**   The economic support that China provides condones North Korea's actions; now,

7                   therefore, be it;

8   **RESOLVED,**   That the Congress here assembled make the following recommendation for a

9                   summit between the countries of the United States, Japan, Russia, and South

10                  Korea with the purpose of encouraging China to cut off economic relations with

11                  North Korea.
