

A Resolution to Join the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (L12)

1 **WHEREAS,** Currently, The United States is not a member of the Asian Infrastructure
2 Investment Bank (AIIB); and

3 **WHEREAS,** The absence of the United States' and other global superpowers'
4 presence allows China to hold a disproportionate voting power in the
5 AIIB; and

6 **WHEREAS,** This allows China to dictate the decisions of the bank, and China has
7 made unstable investments and loans in the past; and

8 **WHEREAS,** The United States becoming a member will help ensure the bank is held
9 to higher standards in its practices, as well as be beneficial to the United
10 States; now, therefore, be it

11 **RESOLVED,** That the United States should seek membership into the Asian
12 Infrastructure Investment Bank.
