

A Bill to Terminate Aid to Pakistan

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 SECTION 1. The United States will cease all aid to Pakistan.

3 SECTION 2. Aid is defined as military, economic, or humanitarian assistance.

4 SECTION 3. The United States Department of Defense, the United States Department of
5 Treasury, and the United States Agency for International Development will
6 jointly oversee the enforcement and implementation of this legislation.

7 SECTION 4. This law will take effect on December 1, 2017.

8 SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
